Candice Norcott, Ph.D.**



Candice Norcott, Ph.D., is a licensed clinical psychologist and an assistant professor at the University of Chicago's School of Medicine. She formerly was the Director of Behavioral Science at the Cook County-Loyola Family residency program. Prior to that, she spent 3 years developing and implementing services for girls in the Cook County Juvenile Detention Center.

Dr. Norcott received her pre and postdoctoral training in Yale University's Department of Psychiatry and her doctoral training in clinical psychology at the University of Connecticut. In Outpatient Services at the Connecticut Mental Health Center, she worked with adults with serious mental illness who lived in transitional and supported housing. Her dissertation focused on childhood sexual abuse in women and the risk for revictimization in adulthood. Central to her work is a commitment to the empowerment of girls and women, minority advancement in psychology, and cultural competence.

Dr. Norcott is a certified training associate for Dr. Stephanie Covington's trauma-informed and gender-responsive curricula. She has trained for Dr. Covington nationally in a variety of venues, including treatment for adolescent substance abuse, mental health programs, and substance abuse programs in criminal justice settings. She has facilitated *Voices* groups in Connecticut detention and treatment facilities and has participated in the development of the *A Women's Way through The Twelve Steps* training DVD. She also provides consultation on and monitors program fidelity for other Covington curricula.
