She spent several years as trainer in topics such as gender responsive programming for girls, relational/strengths-based programming, recognizing and responding to trauma, and the behavior-motivation system for girls. She has written staff and client handbooks for adult female and juvenile male and female programs. In addition, Ms. Rothschild is a trainer in Dr. Stephanie Covington's *Voices* curriculum. Her work has included program auditing, quality assurance, technical assistance, and co-development of the TIER (Trauma Informed Effective Reinforcement) Model, which is a strategic approach to assist adolescents to develop cognitive, emotional, and behavioral awareness and to support the development and exhibition of positive, safe and pro-social behaviors.
