Tammy Rothschild is a private consultant who specializes in gender-responsive programming for women and girls. Her work over the last 15 years has been focused on research in best practices, program development, program assessment, and training and curriculum development. Ms. Rothschild co-developed the TRI Model, a behavior motivation system for girls that has been implemented in the Connecticut state-funded alternative to detention programs, community residential programs, and community detention centers. She spent several years at a training academy as a trainer in topics such as gender-responsive programming for girls, relational/strengths-based programming, recognizing and responding to trauma, and a behavior motivation system for girls. She has written staff and client handbooks for adult female and juvenile male and female programs. In addition, Ms. Rothschild is a trainer in Dr. Stephanie Covington's *Voices* curriculum, and her work has included program auditing, quality assurance, technical assistance, and co-development of the TIER (Trauma Informed Effective Reinforcement) Model -- a trauma-informed behavior motivation system that provides a strategic approach in assisting adolescents to develop cognitive, emotional, and behavioral awareness and to support the development and exhibition of positive, safe, and pro-social behaviors.
