Tammy Rothschild is a private consultant who specializes in gender-responsive and trauma-informed programming for women and girls. She has spent over 15 years doing research in best practices, program development, and program assessment, in addition to providing training and curriculum development.

Ms. Rothschild was the Gender Responsive Consultant for the State of Connecticut Judicial Branch, Court Support Services Division, for 5 years, during which she provided training, quality assurance, and technical assistance in juvenile detention centers, alternatives to detention programs, and other at-risk youth facilities. She also co-developed the Behavior Motivation System for Girls, which has been implemented in the Connecticut state-funded alternative to detention programs, community residential programs, and community detention centers.

Ms. Rothschild is a certified trainer in Dr. Stephanie Covington's *Voices* curriculum. In addition, Ms. Rothschild's work has included program auditing, quality assurance, technical assistance, and co-development of the *TIER (Trauma Informed Effective Reinforcement)* Model, a trauma-informed behavior motivation system that provides a strategic approach to assist women and adolescent girls and boys to develop cognitive, emotional, and behavioral awareness and to support the development and exhibition of positive, safe, and pro-social behaviors. It is now the foundational program model for several juvenile detention and treatment centers in the State of Alaska.
